We will spend some time working on trees at this meeting. So if you have any trees you would like to work on or need some styling advice for, please bring them in.

Now is a good time to check and remove any old wire from your trees. This is when pines put on their new wood so wires that looked loose last month may be cutting in now. You should be fertilizing with a 0-10-10. Clean out dead leaves, seedpods, etc., from your trees. You may want

to spray your tree with a fungicide and insecticide to cut down on unwanted pests.

This last weekend, Jerry escorted a small group of club members on a collecting trek through the Olympic mountains. Each participant found at least one nice tree. What an excellent opportunity to observe the natural environment of the trees and their

growth patterns under more rugged conditions. As a side note, we gathered some moss from a shaded bank for future use in layering trees. Later when a couple trees were collected with minimal or no soil adhering to the roots, the moss provided an great medium to pack the root systems. This could keep those exposed moist until repotting.
